2007-2008 Policy

Payment Information:

Payment of \$50 is due the first lesson of every month. Payment can be made by cash, personal check, money order, Visa, MasterCard, or PayPal.

A \$10 late payment penalty is added to any account that is due on the first lesson of the month but is not received by the second lesson of the month. Failure to remit the late payment penalty and the current tuition payment before the end of the month will necessitate dismissal of the student.

There will be a \$25 processing fee added for a personal check returned due to insufficient funds.

There will be no tuition credits or make-up lessons for missed lessons unless the instructor cancels.

The student will pay for all required books and materials.

Parent/Guardian Requirements:

Schedule consistent, daily practice times for your child. Provide a quiet place in which to practice. Turn off the TV, radio, etc.

Never use practice as a punishment.

Read your child's lesson assignment. Make sure that each instruction is practiced.

Remain nearby during practice times as often as possible. Acknowledge improvement.

Let your child know how much you enjoy listening to him or her play.

Praise your child's efforts and achievements. Never ridicule or make fun of mistakes or less-than-perfect playing.

Encourage your child to play for family and friends. Never insist your child play for others if he or she doesn't want to. Never apologize to others for your child's weak performance.

Expose your child to a wide variety of music. Help him or her build a personal music library.

Encourage your child to talk with you about his or her lessons. You are welcome to attend the lessons.

Student Requirements:

Be on time to your music lesson. It is reserved for you.

Come to your music lesson with a positive attitude.

Practice regularly at home. You will learn more with a little bit of practice every day than with one long practice session the day before your music lesson.

Bring all materials and your assignment notebook (provided) to every lesson.

Have fun. Enjoy making music. Feel free to play or compose music other than your assigned music during your practice sessions.
